As part of the Maintenance and Integrity organization, this role is responsible for the coordination and implementation of pipeline integrity and risk management for the Drayton Valley field area.

Responsibilities

Duties include the following, but are not limited to:

- Provide guidance and support to both Operations and Technical Services to ensure the requirements of the Pipeline Integrity Management System are met including pipeline discontinuations and abandonments
- Ensure that risk assessments are conducted on oil, gas and water pipelines
- Provide technical support to Operations with respect to the development, implementation, and management of pipeline corrosion mitigation programs
- Provide technical input and support pertaining to pipeline maintenance procedures
- Participate in pipeline design reviews including optimization projects and Management of Change
- Conduct annual pipeline risk assessments, summarize the findings and ensure resulting actions are captured in the event reporting databases to create assurance of completion
- Assist with the investigation of pipeline failures to determine the root cause and support the implementation of recommendations to prevent recurrence
- Compile monthly and quarterly pipeline integrity performance reports and distribute to the required stakeholders



- Identify continuous improvement opportunities to optimize pipeline corrosion mitigation programs
- Support health, safety, environmental, and regulatory behaviours through day-to-day activities

- Minimum 10 years of upstream oil and gas pipeline integrity management
