I recieved your letter this evening, I'd like to just write you and tell you a couple things.

The entire time this case has been pending, I was facing 6 felony charges, the highest one being a level 3 Aggravated Battery.

When I got here I was coming down off psych meds, & the day I was told my mom died I was called down to talk to my lawyer. He verbally told me, if I didn't take a 16 yr plea on the level 3 felony, they would file M1 & attempted murder, I was already w/ sin my mind & was like no way, how can they? He DID NOT have a plea there for me, so I assumed like always they would send me one in black & white to either sign or NOT. But however a couple days later I was pulled into court

With the Attempted Murder Charge !!
My 1st Attorney DID NOT
Properly represent me. ~~_____~~
My new lawyer tried to get that plea
Brock. I would have signed
that because I HAVE HUNTINGTONS
DISEASE & am dying, why would
I willing take more time??

2nd. My life has been Full of Abuse
Sexual, mental & Physical starting
at a very young age. I've never
received help! has led to
Drug Addiction that's destroyed
my life. I genuinely don't remember
the incident with Tom & I, I had
been up for days, was hallucinating
and had a female friend over &
mixed drugs, which I've never done,
the next thing I knew I was on
top of Tom with a HAMMER in
my HAND " He & I have had a
GREAT AND BAD Decade,
we've been enablers to one another
BUT HE DIDNT DESERVE WHAT
HAPPEN THAT DAY. IT CRUSHES

My soul And There's NOT A
word that describes the remorse
I feel, I'm terribly sorry for the
pain I've caused Him!

I'm Always reading in the paper How
they now coming out with new
courts that are designed to
help people with mental, Drug
issues, I think that's Amazing,
I wish to God there would've
been something like that to help
me.

If you do anything with this letter I
need you to report it all, I feel
like I was wrongfully represented
in the beginning of this case,
I've read Tom's letter to the
court, He'd like for me to get
15 years! I pray the courts take
that into consideration.
