The YMCA of Lethbridge Code of Conduct embodies the mission and values of the YMCA. It ensures our members, participants, and visitors always feel comfortable and safe while using YMCA of Lethbridge facilities.

As a Member, participant, or visitor you agree to follow our YMCA of Lethbridge Code of Conduct. This Code of Conduct is based on the values of caring, honesty, inclusiveness, respect, responsibility and providing an environment where all community members have a place to belong and thrive. The following behaviors are prohibited at the YMCA of Lethbridge facilities, programs, services, and online communities:

1. **Inappropriate attire:** It is prohibited to wear clothing with vulgar language, obscure images, racial slurs, or anything that contributes to a hostile environment or inappropriate for a family environment.
2. **Inappropriate language:** Hostile or vulgar language, including but not limited to; swearing, shouting and name calling.
3. **Inappropriate conduct:** Any conduct of inappropriate, threatening, or offensive nature.
4. **Threatening physical contact:** Any threats or hostile physical conduct with another individual. This includes play and mock fighting.
5. **Sexual activity:** All conduct or demonstration of sexual activity.
6. **Harassment/intimidation:** All forms of harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language, or behavior that demeans another person or religion.
7. **Exclusiveness/ Racism:** All forms of exclusiveness or racism by words, slurs, gestures, body language, or behavior that demeans another person, culture, or race.
8. **Theft:** Any theft on the property of the YMCA of Lethbridge.
9. **Destruction of property:** Destruction of property or behavior that results in the destruction of property.
10. **Weapons:** Any weapon or object that may be used as a weapon (including play or fake items that appear to be real) are banned on all YMCA of Lethbridge properties.
11. **Drugs or alcohol:** Possession, distribution, and sale of drugs or alcohol on YMCA of Lethbridge properties and YMCA of Lethbridge sponsored events and/or programs.
12. **Tobacco:** The use of tobacco or similar products are not permitted within any YMCA of Lethbridge properties or during YMCA of Lethbridge sponsored events and/or programs. This is including but not limited to cigarettes, Vapes, and E-cigarettes.
13. **Loitering:** Loitering is not permitted inside or outside of all YMCA of Lethbridge facilities, programs, or event spaces.
14. **Photography:** All photography within YMCA of Lethbridge facilities is prohibited, including but not limited to all change rooms, gymnasium, fitness floor, multipurpose rooms, and the aquatic center.
15. **Cell phone use:** The use of cell phones within sensitive area of all YMCA of Lethbridge facilities is prohibited. This includes but not limited to, the change rooms, the aquatic center, child-minding, indoor play, childcare centers.
16. **Social Media:** Using social media in a way that contradicts the code of conduct and disrespects members, participants, and visitors.

If a YMCA of Lethbridge Code of Conduct violation has occurred, please report the behavior to a YMCA of Lethbridge Duty Manager (yellow Shirt) or another YMCA of Lethbridge employee.
