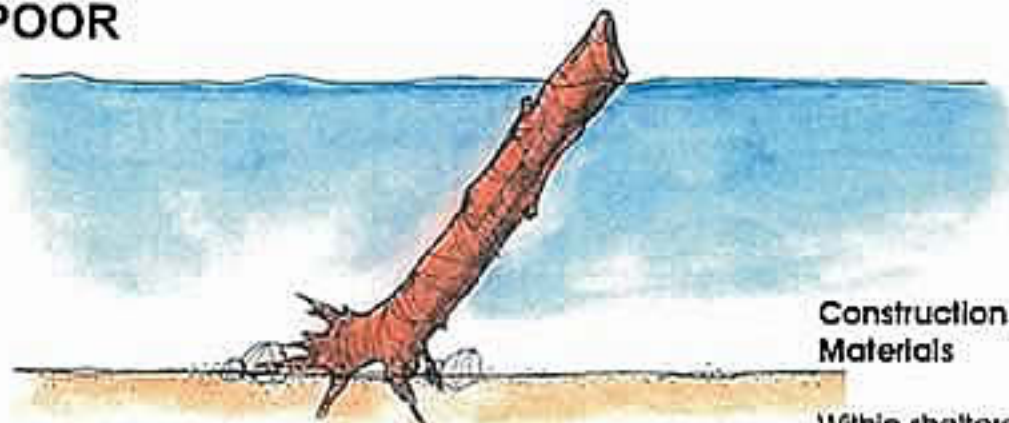


RESTORATION TECHNIQUE: Log Tangles

HABITAT TYPE : Sheltered Embayments / Coastal Wetlands

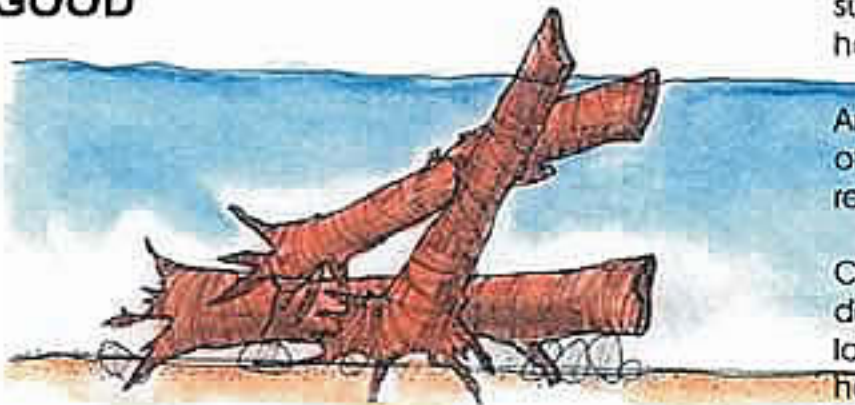
POOR



Construction Techniques and Materials

Within sheltered embayments and low fetch areas deploy a combination of logs and substrates to provide structural habitat.

GOOD



Anchor logs by piling rocks on top of root wads or driving logs to resistance within soft sediments

Combination of vertical deployment of single or multiple logs and rock reefs provide habitat function. Single or multiple logs would function in backwater lagoons within coastal wetlands.

BETTER



Targets

- Increase essential habitats for cool and cold water species
- Improve forage for aquatic species
- Add structural elements to improve near shore habitats
