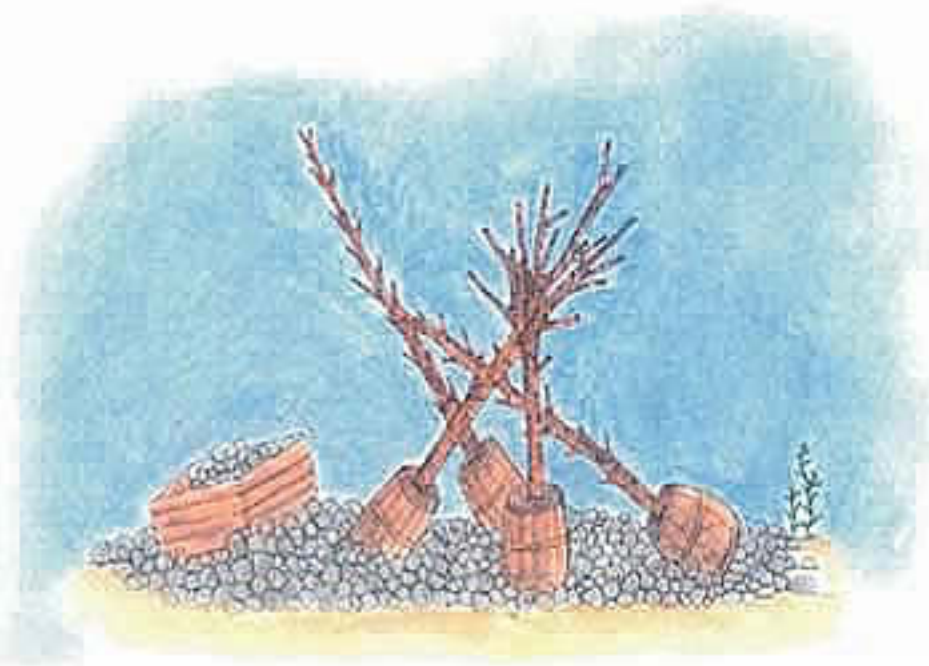


RESTORATION TECHNIQUE: Woody Debris Anchored Logs

HABITAT TYPE : Sheltered Embayments



Construction Techniques and Materials

Within sheltered embayments and low fetch areas deploy a combination of anchored logs and substrates to provide structural habitat.

Anchored logs are weighted down by concrete filled barrels. Allows for a near vertical alignment of woody debris can be associated with additional structures including reefs and log cribs.

Combination of vertical deployment of single or multiple logs and rock reefs provide habitat function. Single or multiple logs would function in backwater lagoons within coastal wetlands and could allow for roosting birds on exposed limbs.

Targets

- Improve submergent vegetation
- Improve forage for aquatic
- Add structural elements to improve near shore habitats
