## Downtown Brampton Flood Protection Project Environmental Assessment

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) and the City of Brampton

The City of Brampton's Downtown Core is subject to flooding during regulatory (extreme) storm events and is therefore subject to land use development restrictions under a Special Policy Area Designation. The City of Brampton and TRCA are considering alternative ways to protect Downtown Brampton from future flood events and unlock potential for revitalization through the Downtown Brampton Flood Protection Environmental Assessment (DBFP EA). The purpose of the DBFP EA is to identify a preferred alternative for providing flood protection for the City of Brampton's Downtown core while considering urban design and land use opportunities for the City of Brampton.
