

The Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA), in partnership with the Regional Municipality of York and the City of Vaughan, is constructing the Kirby Road Multi-use Trail within TRCA's Nashville Conservation Reserve (NCR) property. The scope of work for Phase 2 includes building 705-metres of granular trail, including a 375-metre switchback - touted as one of the largest in TRCA's area of jurisdiction.

Development of the Kirby Road Multi-use Trail is a key recommendation of the NCR Management Plan (2015). The Management Plan was developed in collaboration with members of the public and was subsequently endorsed by the City of Vaughan and the Region of York. Once complete, the trail will provide improved access to NCR and become a key component of both the City of Vaughan's and the Region of York's pedestrian and cycling network.

Phase 2 construction activities are ongoing and are anticipated to be completed in spring 2021. To ensure public safety, sections of trail within construction areas will be closed for the duration of the project. Please respect all posted construction signs and stay clear of work areas and equipment. Your cooperation and patience is appreciated.
