
NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Claireville North Interregional Multi-use Trail

The Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA), in partnership with the City of Brampton, is constructing the Claireville North Interregional Multi-use Trail within TRCA's Claireville Conservation Area (CCA) property. The scope of work includes building 3.4 kilometre granular trail, including the installation of two pedestrian bridges across the West Humber River.

Development of the Claireville North Interregional Multi-use Trail through CCA is a key recommendation of the Claireville Conservation Area Land Management Implementation Plan (2014). The Management Plan was developed in collaboration with the Humber Watershed Alliance, municipal partners and the general public. Once complete, the trail will offer improved access to CCA and provide greater interregional trail connectivity between the City of Brampton and the City of Toronto.

Construction activities are ongoing and are anticipated to be completed in spring 2022. To ensure public safety, sections of trail within the limits of construction will be closed for the duration of the project. Please respect all posted construction signs and stay clear of work areas and equipment. Your cooperation and patience is appreciated.
